

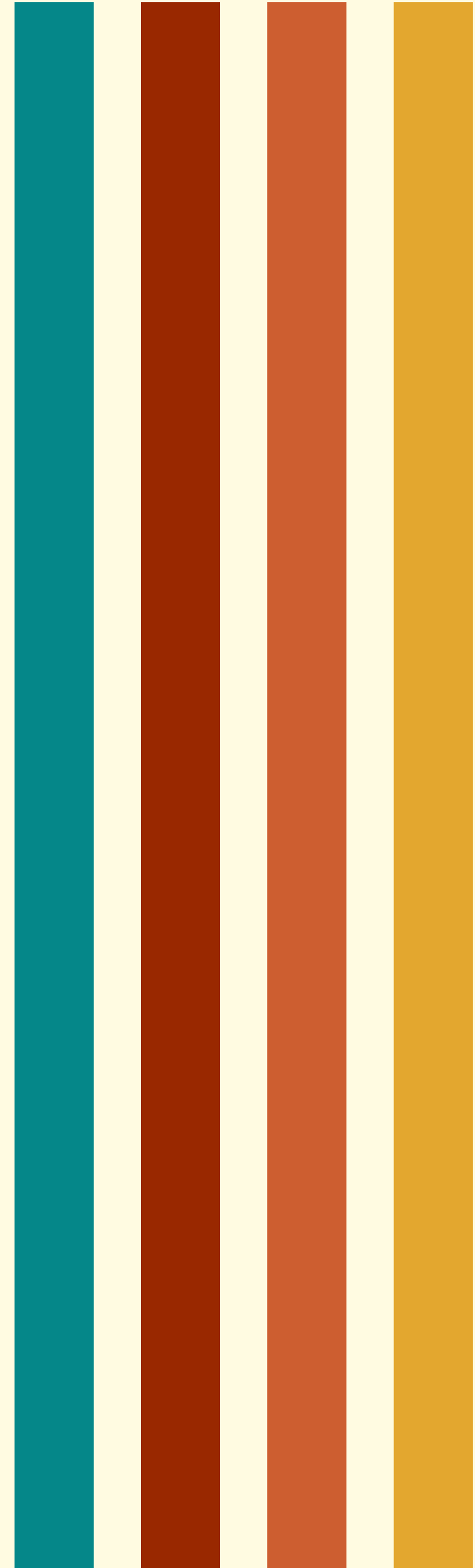

Every employee in the District has a job description which lists the essential functions of their job.

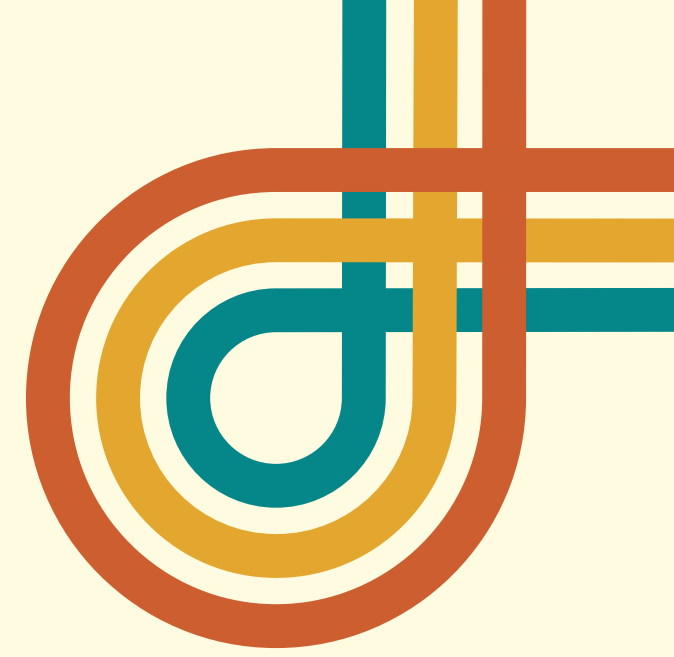

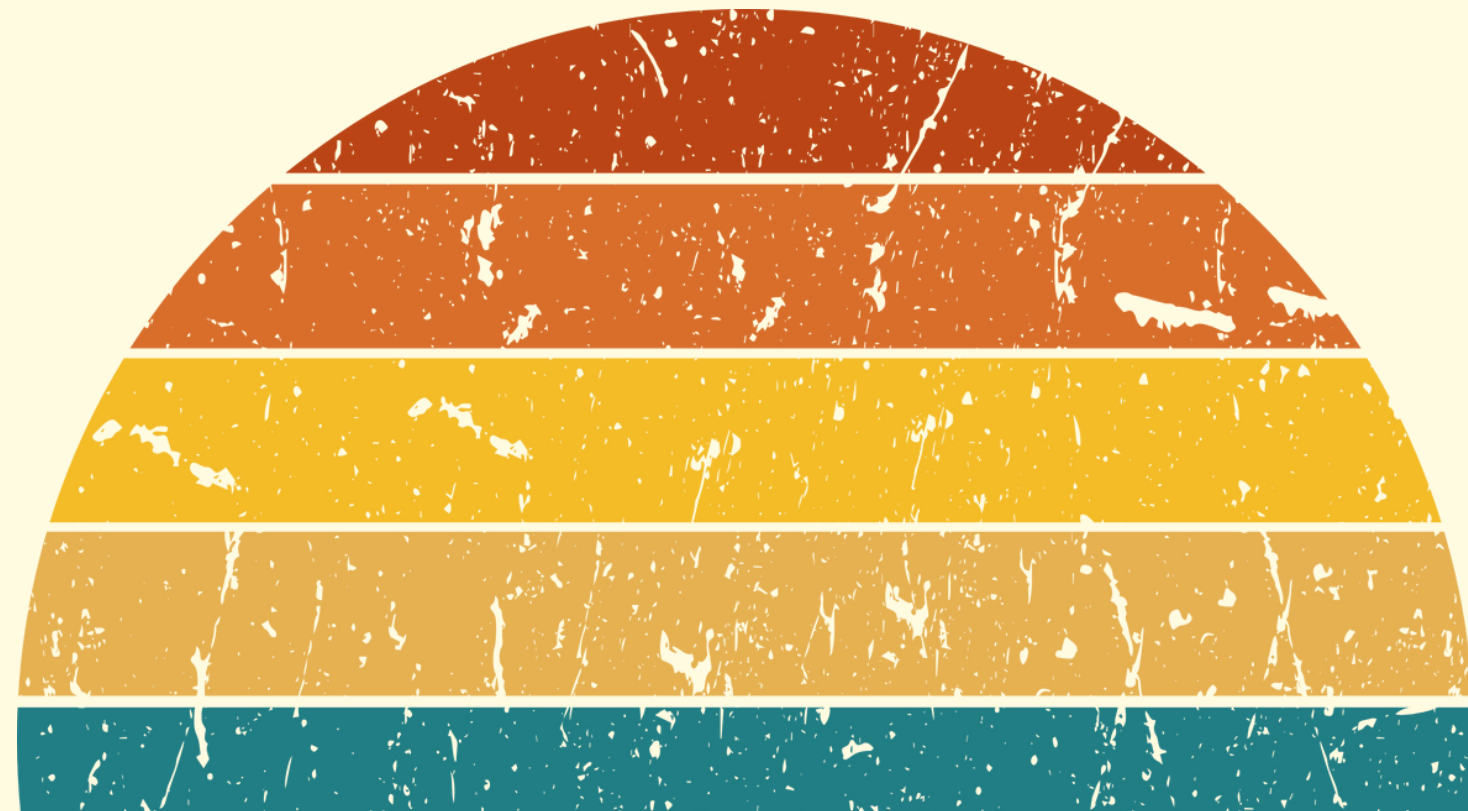

# Student Behavior

Establish and maintain standards of student behavior needed to achieve a functional atmosphere in the classroom through organization and appropriate discipline strategies.

Communicate and cooperate with other professional staff regarding student's academic and personal growth areas.

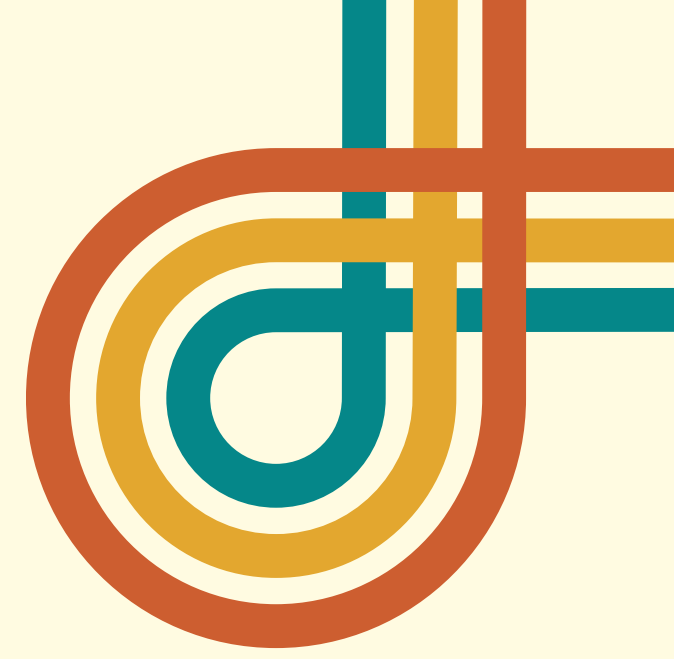


# Be Present
